



Notice of Race

Junior Keelboat Regatta August 10, 2008

Marblehead, Massachusetts Organizing Authority: Corinthian Yacht Club

1. **Rules**

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing in effect at the time of the regatta, this Notice of Race, except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions, and by the sailing Instructions.

2. **Eligibility and Entry**

The regatta is open to all Marblehead Racing Association one design classes. Skippers must be 23 years of age or younger as of the date of the regatta but crew may be any age, and must complete the regatta entry form.

3. **Schedule of Events**

August 10, 1230 - Warning signal for the first race of the day, subsequent races to follow. No warning signal will be made after 1500.

4. **Advance Registration**

Yachts may register in advance by submitting the entry form and the appropriate fee to the registrar. Registration to the address listed below. The entry form will be available from the Corinthian Yacht Club (www.corinthianyc.org) web site.

5. **Fees**

The fee for registration shall be \$20. Checks are to be made payable to "Corinthian Yacht Club." The entry fee will include one regatta t-shirt and additional regatta t-shirts will be sold for \$10.

6. **Sailing Instructions**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the CYC front desk as well as on the CYC web site after July 15, 2008.

7. **Venue**

Regatta headquarters will be the Corinthian Yacht Club. The racing area will be in the waters of Massachusetts Bay off of Marblehead. Courses will be windward-leeward.

8. **Races and Courses**

We will sail as many races as conditions permit. One race shall constitute a regatta. There is no minimum course length.

9. **Scoring**

The Low-Point Scoring System (Appendix A2 of the Racing Rules of Sailing) will apply. There will be no throw-out unless five or more races are completed.

10. **Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded to the skippers..

11. **Clean Regatta**

This event is designated a **CLEAN REGATTA** by the Sailors for the Sea organization. By entering, all competitors agree to abide by **CLEAN REGATTA** "Best Practices" (available at Skippers' Meeting). Boats observed purposefully discharging trash into the water will either be disqualified from all races the day the infraction is observed or be subject to other suitable disciplinary action, or both.
